

ISA Annual General Meeting – 10 December 2024

Election Procedure

The procedure for the elections of the two (2) Vice President positions and one (1) EC Regular Member position will be as follows.

(2) Vice Presidents (VP)

- Each position will be voted separately.
- There are four (4) eligible candidates for the two (2) positions.
- For the VP position number one, all four (4) eligible candidates will be voted upon by the voting Members with the candidate receiving the majority of the votes being elected.
- If there is no majority in the first round, the candidate with the least number of votes will be eliminated and a second round of voting will be conducted between the three remaining candidates.
- The candidate with the majority of votes from the voting Members will be elected.
- If there is no majority in the second round, the above process will be repeated until a candidate is elected.
- For the VP position number two, the three (3) remaining candidates will be eligible for the election.
- The candidate receiving the majority of votes from the voting Members will be elected.
- If there is no majority in the first round, the candidate with the least number of votes will be eliminated and a second round of voting will be conducted between the two remaining candidates.
- Should there be a tie, the ISA President shall have the casting vote according to Article 8.c which states:

“Each Member will have only one (1) vote. In the event of a tied vote of the Members on any issue, the President of the ISA shall have the right to a tie-break vote.”

(1) Regular EC Member

- Depending on the outcome of the Vice President election, there may be up to five (5) eligible candidates for one (1) position
- The candidate receiving the majority of votes from the voting Members will be elected.

P. 2

- If there is no majority in the first round, the candidate with the least number of votes will be eliminated and a second round of voting will be conducted between the four remaining candidates.
- If there is no majority in the second round, the above process will be repeated until a candidate is elected.
- Should there be a tie, the ISA President shall have the casting vote according to Article 8.c which states:

“Each Member will have only one (1) vote. In the event of a tied vote of the Members on any issue, the President of the ISA shall have the right to a tie-break vote.”
