Re: Explanatory note on security measures in El Salvador

Please receive our warm greetings from the Salvadoran Tourism Corporation, a public agency under the auspices of the Ministry of Tourism in El Salvador.

This letter is to share some information on the current state of affairs in El Salvador in regard to the most recent security measures put in place by our government. On March 27, our Congress passed a series of measures rooted in Article 29 of the Salvadoran Constitution, which seek to improve public security.

These measures have been designed to optimize the operational capacity of security bodies and were put in place in response to an outlier spike in a conflict between rival criminal groups. It is important to underscore that these security measures have no effect on the normal religious, sporting, cultural or businesses activities in the country.
